- 2 With reference to **one** live production that you have seen, explain how lighting **and** set were used to create specific effects for the audience at particular moments in the production.
- 3 Choose **two** of the following elements sound, use of space, set and explain how these elements helped to communicate the production intentions of **one** live production that you have seen.
- 4 Outline the design of the costumes in **one** live production that you have seen and explain how their design and their use created specific effects for the audience.
