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How were fifteenth-century architects influenced by classical antiquity? Refer to **three** examples of fifteenth-century architecture in your answer. (30 marks)

Analyse **three** seventeenth-century paintings **and/or** sculptures that are concerned with the lives of the saints. How is religious purpose conveyed in each work?

Analyse **and** interpret **three** seventeenth-century paintings of still-life **and/or** scenes of everyday life. (30 marks)

Question 7



Discuss how character and identity are conveyed in **three** seventeenth-century portraits of two or more figures. (30 marks)

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Analyse **three** palaces **and/or** country houses that were built in the seventeenth century. Discuss how each communicates status. (30 marks)

Analyse three nineteenth-century public and/or institutional buildings and discuss the style of each. (30 marks)
