- **9 (b) (ii)** Why would the Mycenaeans have considered Mycenae safe from attack? (8 marks)
- **9 (b) (iii)** 'The Mycenaeans were not only warlike.' Do you agree with this statement? Give your reasons and support your answer with archaeological evidence. (10 marks)
